



AMBASSADOR PROGRAM

The Ambassador program is a collaboration between SAI programs and the PLNU Office of Global Studies. It incorporates both professional development as well as a financial incentive. Hours of work may vary, though participants will be expected to work between 2-3 hours per week for the semester they have been appointed. There will be only one Ambassador on campus per semester.

PLNU Ambassadors will:

- Receive a training manual, materials to be used for promotional activities, and support from the SAI Ambassador Coordinator, Rod Harris.
- Facilitate group informational sessions about studying abroad in Italy (i.e., classroom presentations, clubs, and/or organizations on campus)
- Submit one article for the SAI blog
- Engage in at least one social media platform promoting SAI programs in Italy
- Assist during study abroad fairs
- Distribute SAI posters on campus
- Host an SAI information table in common area
- Assist potential SAI students by answering questions prior to their departure.

Successful PLNU Ambassadors will:

- Gain valuable experience for their resume
- Receive letters of reference and/or recommendation
- Be provided with paid registration for the reentry conference, Lessons from Abroad
- Be eligible for a paid summer internship at SAI's main office in Sebastopol, California
- Receive a \$250 stipend at the conclusion of their ambassadorship.
- Be eligible for complementary registration at the NAFSA: Association of International Educators conference in the western region. NAFSA is the leading professional organization for building international education and an excellent platform from which to begin a career.
